Santa Rosa Water Reserve Policy

- Council Policy 000-57
 - Last update 2012
- In accord with the Association of California Water Agencies (ACWA)
 Policy Principles and Guidelines for Water Districts issued in 2005

Reasons for Reserves

- Available when needed for specific purposes
 - Must be reasonable and specific
- Sound financial management
 - Favorably affects bond ratings
 - Balances fluctuations in revenue
- Ensures ability to carry out our mission in times of trouble
 - Available for unforeseen costs or events

Specific Reserves

- Operating Reserves 15% of Operations and Maintenance budget
- Bond Specified and Designated Reserves
- Geysers Reserve
- Subregional User Agency Reserve
- Catastrophic Reserve


Catastrophic Reserve

- 2015 Rate Study recommendation
 - Increase current reserve target by 30% to account for construction index increase since 2006

| Catastrophic Neserves | | | |


Historical Reserve Balance - Water
