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City Resolution / County Ordinance

City of Santa Rosa

Resolution No. 25954

- Passed on May 4, 2004
- Consents to the inclusion of the City of Santa Rosa within the proposed Sonoma County Tourism Business Improvement Area (SCTBIA)

County of Sonoma

Ordinance No. 5525 / Sonoma County Code Chapter 33

- Passed on November 2, 2004
- Established the SCTBIA
- Participating jurisdictions:
 - Unincorporated Sonoma County
 - All incorporated cities in Sonoma County except Healdsburg and Sonoma



Collection of Assessments

The SCTBIA allows for:

A 2% levy

- Of rent charged by lodging operators
- Assessed on those operators generating total gross rent greater than \$350,000/FY

For the purpose of

Marketing activities designed to increase overnight visits to the area

Economic Impact of Tourism

Tourism Revenue Streams:

- Transient Occupancy Tax (TOT)
- Sales Tax
- Santa Rosa Tourism Business Improvement Area Assessment

2016 Tourism Data Points

- Destination spending, TOT receipts, industry earnings and local and state tax receipts are the highest Sonoma County has seen in a decade
- Leisure and hospitality employment is approximately 25% higher than the prerecession peak
- Average daily rates for Sonoma County hotels rose 14% in 2014, 9% in 2015 and a further 6% in the first few months of 2016
- Average occupancy rates are approximately 75%
- In 2014 Santa Rosa captured 16% of the County's \$28m TOT revenue



Santa Rosa Tourism Assessments and Taxes

Taxes and assessments on overnight visitors

9% Transient Occupancy Tax

2% Sonoma County Tourism Business Improvement Area Assessment

3% Santa Rosa Tourism Business Improvement Area Assessment

Recommendation

It is recommended by the Planning and Economic Development Department that the Council, by resolution,

 Approve a retroactive agreement for collection of assessments on Santa Rosa lodging establishments resulting from Santa Rosa's participation in the Sonoma County Tourism Business Improvement Area (SRTBIA) per Resolution Number 25954.

It is further recommended that the Council, by resolution,

 Authorize the remittance of any assessment funds collected but not remitted between June 30, 2015, and the signing of a new agreement.
