WHEREAS, the traditional cultural and ecological knowledge of the Pomo and Wappo people hold important values for our community; and

WHEREAS, the Santa Rosa community will benefit from more active and visible input of the Pomo and Wappo people.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that I Natalie Rogers, Mayor of the city of Santa Rosa, on behalf of the entire City Council, in recognition of our community, do hereby proclaims that the month of October shall be
