

Amendment No. 1
Memorandum of Understanding (MOU)

Pilot Program -- Unlimited Access Pass for College Students on Santa Rosa CityBus

Agreed to by the following parties:

*The Sonoma County Junior College District (SCJCD), SCJCD Associated Students,
and the City of Santa Rosa*

RECITALS

- A. The parties entered into the MOU for a student CityBus ridership pilot program during the fall semester 2017 under which Citybus would allow unlimited ridership to college students which would be funded by the SCJCD from revenue generated from the Student Transportation Fee (STF).
- B. SRJC student ridership on Citybus has averaged around 2,500 per week, which is less than original pilot program ridership estimates of 5,000 rides per week.
- C. The parties believe the maturation of the pilot program will take up to two years.
- D. The STF is expected to generate enough funding to cover the costs of providing unlimited ridership on CityBus through June 30, 2018.
- E. City is willing to extend the program and SCJCD is willing to fund the program through June 30, 2018.

NOW, THEREFORE, the parties agree to amend the MOU as follows:

- 1. The term of the MOU is extended through June 30, 2018.
- 2. The SCJCD shall pay the City of Santa Rosa to allow SRJC students to ride CityBus for the fall and spring semesters and through June 30, 2018 an unlimited number of times. The SCJCD shall pay to the City of Santa Rosa at \$.77 per ride. The SRJC has \$100,000 available to pay the City at this per ride rate of \$.77. In the event additional STF revenue is available for the pilot program, additional funding will be paid to the City at \$.77 per ride. SCJCD shall notify City of the availability of additional funding upon request by City.

All other terms and conditions of the MOU remain in full force and effect. In the event of a conflict between this Amendment and the MOU, this Amendment shall control.
