

APPROVAL OF PURCHASE ORDERS FOR VARIOUS HEAVY EQUIPMENT PURCHASES UNDER SOURCEWELL/NJPA COOPERATIVE AGREEMENTS

CURRENT

The Transportation and Public Works
Department (TPW) has a need to
purchase various heavy equipment
items under the Fleet vehicle
replacement program.

PROPOSED

- The Transportation and Public Works
 Department requests to purchase
 various heavy equipment needs
 through Sourcewell/NJPA cooperative
 agreements.
- The City of Santa Rosa is a registered agency authorized to utilize Sourcewell/NJPA Cooperative Agreements under registration ID #79480.

PROPOSED (Continued)

- The Purchase Orders (PO) issued will be accompanied with City PO Terms and Conditions.
- PO's will be issued to authorized distributors of the equipment manufacturer's who were awarded the cooperative agreement with NJPA.

BENEFIT

- Santa Rosa City Code Section 3-08.160 allows for cooperative purchases when advantageous to the City.
- Sourcewell/NJPA, formerly National Joint Powers Alliance, was created by state law as a service cooperative to provide programs and services to members in education and government
- Sourcewell/NJPA serves over 50,000 member agencies nationally. All contracts are subject to periodic business reviews throughout the term of the contract to ensure compliance.

RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended by the Transportation and Public Work and Finance Department that the Council, by resolution, approve four purchase orders for various equipment through Sourcewell/National Joint Powers Alliance (NJPA) Cooperative Agreements for various heavy equipment in a total amount of \$3,432,819.29 as follows: 1) Contract #032119-JDC to Pape Machinery, Rohnert Park, CA in the amount of \$423,152; 2) Contract #032119-JDC to Nixon-Egli Equipment Company, Tracy, CA in the amount of \$277,815.37; 3) Contract #052417-PBL to PB Loader Corp, Fresno, CA in the amount of \$733,459; and 4) Contract #122017-AMI to Vac-Con Inc, Green Cove Springs, Florida, in the amount of \$1,998,392.92.
