Housing Action Plan

- Program Areas
 - Increase inclusionary affordable housing
 - Achieve "Affordability by design" in market-rate projects
 - Assemble and offer public land for housing development
 - 3. Improve development readiness
 - Increase affordable housing investment and partnerships

Affordable Housing Resources

- Historic funding mechanisms
 - 2012 Dissolution of the Redevelopment Agency (RDA)
 - RDA provided \$3.6 million annually

- Future Funding Expectations?
 - One time funds vs ongoing?
 - Re-establish local match resource?
