Limited Preference for Disaster-Affected Families

- Only a certain number of vouchers are made available under a Limited Preference and are used as a tool to respond to an urgent, unmet local need
- Forty-eight vouchers are currently set aside for households that resided in city limits and were displaced as a result of the wildfires
- The proposed change qualifies affected households from outside city limits and has the potential to resolve the unmet housing needs of all families who were still receiving FEMA assistance as of May 2019

Recommendation

- Housing and Community Services recommends that the Housing Authority, by resolution, adopt the revision to Chapter 4, Section 4-III.C of the Housing Choice Voucher Program Administrative Plan dated May 20, 2019.
