


- Application to the So. Co. Ag. Preservation & Open Space District's Matching Grant Program
- Grant request: \$532,390
- Construction estimate: \$2.5 million
- Secured grant funds:
 - \$941,224 CA Urban Streams Restoration Program
 - \$617,710 So. Co. Ag. Preservation & Open Space District
- Other funds to come from City's Storm Water Enterprise Fund



- Resolution required to:
 - Authorize grant application
 - Certify sufficient matching funds
 - Certify consistency with the General Plan
 - Certify sufficient funding for O&M
 - Agree to Program Guidelines
 - Delegate authority to the Director of SR Water
 - Agree to comply with all federal, state, and local laws
 - Appropriate funds if awarded the grant





- Restore a ~1,900 feet flood control channel
 - Create meandering channel
 - Construct in-stream habitat features
- Plant 1,200 native riparian trees & shrubs
- Increase flood capacity from 25 to 100 year level
- Construct paved bicycle & pedestrian pathway







It is recommended by the Transportation & Public Works and Water Departments, that the Council, by resolution: 1) approve a matching grant application to the Sonoma County Agricultural Preservation and Open Space District for construction of the Lower Colgan Creek Restoration – Phase 2 Project in the amount of \$532,390 and authorize the Director of Santa Rosa Water (Director) to submit a grant application; 2) authorize the Director to accept the grant and execute any and all grant agreements and amendments thereto, and all other documents necessary for the completion of the project, subject to approval by the City Attorney; and 3) authorize the Chief Financial Officer to increase appropriations by the approved grant award.
