# Background

- Sonoma County CoC made available ESG-CV (coronavirus) funding for eligible homeless services with tight expenditure deadlines
- Staff submitted funding requests for Sam Jones Hall operating expenses
- Round 1 - \$651,224
- Round 2 - \$390,533
- Total - \$1,041,757

# Background

- Expedited execution of grant agreements (2) by City Manager
- Request by Sonoma County CDC (CoC lead agency) to meet expenditure deadlines
- Secure funding for City
- Offset City General Fund for SJH Annex – Approx. \$2.6 million

# Council Request

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- Ratification of grant agreements (2) with Sonoma County CDC for funding of operations during the COVID-19 pandemic at SJH
- Includes existing facility and SJH Annex

# Recommendation

- It is recommended by the City Manager's Office that Council, by resolution, ratify two (2) grant agreements with the Sonoma County Community Development Commission for funding of operations during the COVID-19 pandemic at the Samuel L. Jones Hall Homeless Shelter in the combined total amount of \$1,041,757, including:
