



Transportation Development Act (TDA) Article 3 Grant Application For Fiscal Year 2018/2019

BACKGROUND

- Transportation Development Act (TDA) funds are generated from a statewide ¼ cent sales tax. Article 3 of TDA sets aside of approximately 2% of those monies for bicycle and pedestrian planning and projects. The Metropolitan Transportation Commission (MTC) administers TDA Article 3, which is distributed based on population.
- The City annually receives TDA Article 3 funding for bicycle and pedestrian projects. The City's available fund balance for FY 2018/19 is \$163,806.

RECOMMENDATION

- (1) request that the Metropolitan Transportation Commission (MTC) allocate \$90,000 from Fiscal Year 2018/2019 Transportation Development Act (TDA) Article 3 funds;
- (2) authorize the Director of Transportation and Public Works to file the application and other required documents to install Class II bike lanes on E Street between College Avenue and Sonoma Avenue, and
- (3) authorize the Chief Financial Officer to increase appropriations in JL Key 17593 E Street Class II bike lanes by \$90,000.
