



Question 1: Where do you live within the City of Santa Rosa?

















Question 18: Should parks which have been named in honor of individuals be renamed?







Question 1: Where do you live within the City of Santa Rosa?














Question 12: Is changing the Creekside Open Space park name to Mary M.

Traverso "compatible with community interest"?








Question 15: Should the community be involved in the naming and renaming of parks?


Question 16: How should an individual, group or organization's significant service

contribution to city, country or the field of Recreation & Parks be measured?







Question 20: Should a park monument sign be installed as part of the renaming process?









Question 1: Where do you live within the City of Santa Rosa?





Question 2: What is your age group?









Question 7: How often do you visit Creekside Open Space?







Question 10: Are Mary M. Traverso's civic contributions an "occurrence or event of national or local significance"?









- She is so deserving of this space.





Question 1: Where do you live within the City of Santa Rosa?













Question 7: How often do you visit Creekside Open Space?












Question 15: Should the community be involved in the naming and renaming of parks?










Question 20: Should a park monument sign be installed as part of the renaming process?


