CURRENT

- In 1990 Council authorized JPA Agreement with CalTIP
- In 2011, Council authorized amended JPA agreement with CalTIP
- CalTIP provides excess liability insurance for CityBus beyond the \$250,000 self-insurance limits

BENEFIT

- Oversight of liability insurance program costs and services; stability of insurance premiums; availability of coverage; and additional services,
- Networking opportunities in the Transit community with other small public transit providers throughout the state.
- Training to CityBus operations staff by CalTIP on various safety and injury prevention issues

RECOMMENDATION

- It is recommended by the Transportation and Public Works Department, that the Council, by resolution, authorize the City Manager or their designee to execute the Amended and Restated Joint Powers Authority Agreement with California Transit Systems Joint Powers Authority (CalTIP).
