

CONTRACT EXTENSION -TENTH AMENDMENT F000799 GOLDEN GATE LANDSCAPE MANAGEMENT SYSTEMS

CURRENT

- On August 5, 2014, the City Council approved GSA F000799 for a three-year term with two (2) one-year extension options for landscape services.
- The proposed GSA extension provides for the continued maintenance of landscapes without the use of Glyphosate throughout the greater Santa Rosa area for one additional year.

CURRENT CONTRACT

- Three key parts, mowing, facility maintenance and weed spraying
- Contractor abides by City's Storm Water Permit, Healthy Schools Act, and State Regulations
- Utilizes an Integrated Pest Management system
- Contractor will only use Organic Materials Review Institute (OMRI) approved products for weed control (no Glyphosate used)

CURRENT CONTRACT..(cont.)

- Weed Control (spraying) is not used at playgrounds, dog parks, community gardens, picnic areas, creeks or near day care facilities or when people are present, before or after rain or wind
- Weed control is used at pavement cracks, tree rings, ball field warning track, bollards and at base of signs
- Regulated by the State, requires permit including OMRI approved

PROPOSED

- Extending the term of the GSA for an additional year of services to continue service with no pricing increase.
- Adding additional \$509,789.84 in compensation.
- Memorialize the \$40,000 of contingency spend previously awarded in the original Agreement by Council with the GSA's total cumulative spend.

BENEFIT

- Allows the City to receive:
 - Set fees for continued landscape maintenance services.
 - Ongoing landscape services will continue without the use of Glyphosate to maintain City properties, frontages and medians throughout Santa Rosa while City undergoes thorough solicitation process

RECOMMENDATION

 It is recommended by the Finance and **Recreation & Parks Departments, that** the Council, by resolution, approve a Tenth Amendment to GSA F000799, Golden Gate Landscape Management Systems, LLC, Inc. to exercise the last one year renewal option with no increase to service rates, in the total Agreement amount not to exceed \$2,579,337.84.
