## SOCCER AND BASEBALL GRANT

- Grant application State Department of Parks and Recreation
- California Youth Soccer and Recreation Development Program (Grant Program ) Prop 40
- A Place to Play Park
- Application to construct one combination soccer and baseball field near the east park entry

### SOCCER AND BASEBALL GRANT

- Grant program is competitive
- If match provided, application receives higher score
- All non-constructions costs eligible as match
- \$150,000 match for design available
  Zone 1 parkland dedication funds
- Maximum award of \$1,000,000

### RECOMMENDATION

 It is recommended by the Recreation and Parks Department that Council, by resolution, (1) approve the submittal of a California Youth Soccer and Recreation Development Program grant application to the State Department of Parks and Recreation in the amount of \$1 million to construct one combination soccer and baseball field at A Place to Play Park; and (2) and authorize the Director of Recreation and Parks to submit the application, execute agreement and any amendments, subject to approval by City Attorney, and administer the grant; and (3) authorize the Chief Financial Officer to increase appropriations in revenue and expenditures by the approved grant award.
