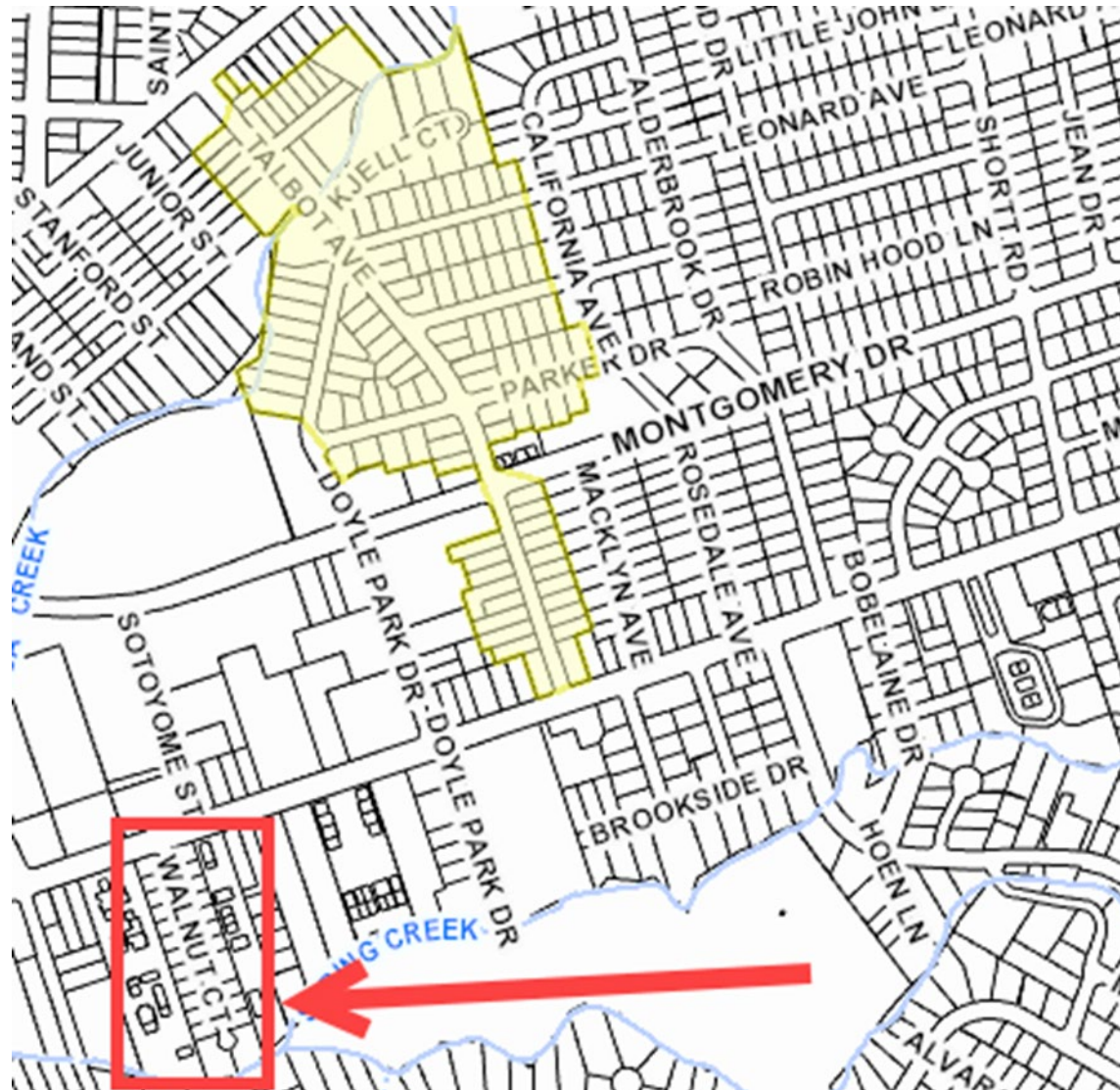
CURRENT

- Walnut Court currently has time limited parking of 2 hours, Mondays-Fridays 9AM-4PM
- Walnut Court does not currently have a residential permit program
- City Code Section 11-44.050 establishes process for designation of a permit zone

PROPOSED

- A petition has been received from residents of Walnut Court to be included in the Talbot area Residential Permit Parking Zone
- Residents may purchase permits exempting them from time limits

TALBOT AREA RESIDENTIAL PERMIT PARKING ZONE



BENEFIT

- Approval of this item will provide relief to residents, allowing them to park beyond posted time limits in the permit zone.
- The two-hour time limit will serve as a deterrent to long term spill over parking, freeing up parking spaces for residents.

RECOMMENDATION

- It is recommended by the Finance Department that Council, by resolution, approve the Walnut Court petition to be included in the Talbot area Residential Permit Parking Program.
