CURRENT

- Scheidt & Bachmann parking access and revenue control equipment.
- System installed in 2001 and is beyond its useful life.



PROPOSED

- Remove and replace existing system with latest technology.
- Sentry Control Systems, Inc., formally merged with surviving corporation SkiData, Inc., was found to be the best value for City upon completion of Request for Proposals 18-117.

BENEFIT

- Advanced technology and features including bar code entry tickets, on-line permit account management and chip credit card processing.
- Increased uptime of equipment.
- Less staff time spent on repairs and maintenance.
- Bar code validation options.
- Future proofed with open architecture to develop Application Programming Interfaces (API)

RECOMMENDATION

- It is recommended by the Finance Department that the Council, by resolution, 1) award a Design-Build Contract for removal and installation of the City's current Parking Access and Revenue Control System; and 2) approve an Agreement for the Purchase, Implementation, and Maintenance of a Parking Access and Revenue Control System between the City of Santa Rosa and SkiData, Inc. in an amount not to exceed \$2,082,876.00. The source of funds is the Parking Fund. No City General Fund money is included in this project.
