



# Parking



# Parking

- Last six months: transactions ~64% of pre-COVID
- Where people park:

	2021	2019
• On Street:	63%	64%
• Lots:	15%	16%
• Garages:	22%	20%


- Percentage of parkers utilizing garages remains essentially unchanged despite Council's garage fee waivers.

# Council Fee Reductions

• Waiver of meter reservation fees for temp. parklets	\$320,000
• Free parking at 1 <sup>st</sup> , 3 <sup>rd</sup> , & 7 <sup>th</sup> St garages on weekends	\$148,000
• Free garage parking 5PM-6AM Monday-Friday	\$179,000
• Free Saturday parking at 5 <sup>th</sup> & D St garages	\$37,000
• First hour free at 3 <sup>rd</sup> , 5 <sup>th</sup> , & D St garages	\$117,000
• Value Zone rate reduction \$1.00-->\$0.75/hr (6mos)	\$41,000
• <u>One free Passport mobile session</u>	<u>\$370</u>
• <b>Actual fee reductions July, 2020 – December, 2021</b>	<b>\$842,370</b>
• Estimated fee reductions January 2022 – June 2022	\$370,000

# Courthouse Square EV Parking

- 4 general parking spaces which also served as EV charging to be converted to **EV charging only** spaces
- As before, parkers must activate both the EV charger and meter
- Ground stencil and new signage being ordered
- Conversion expected to be completed March 2022, weather pending
