HISTORY

- 11/15 – 2/16 LHMP was updated by staff
- 1/17 - Council adopted the updated plan
- 12/17 – Staff created an application to develop the CWPP
- 6/18 – Application reviewed by State and Federal officials and funding awarded
- 12/18 – RFP process opened to solicit proposals for the development of the CWPP
- 1/19 – Four proposals received and reviewed by staff and Geo Elements, LLC was selected for the project

PROPOSED

- Four proposals were received and evaluated
- Geo Elements, LLC submitted a proposal that scored the highest due to their prior fire service experience in developing these types of plans
- Geo Elements, LLC's proposed cost is less than the authorized award amount for these services

RECOMMENDATION

- It is recommended by the Fire Department that the Council, by resolution, approve a professional services agreement (PSA) with Geo Elements, LLC of Leeds, Utah, for the development of a Wildfire Annex to the existing Local Hazard Mitigation Plan and creation of a Community Wildfire Protection Plan in compliance with the Healthy Forests Restoration Act in an amount not to exceed \$200,000.
