

Approval of Pavement Restoration Funding Agreement within the Tubbs Fire Burn Area

PURPOSE

 Seeking approval to accept \$1,328,325.00 from PG&E for future pavement restoration work in neighborhoods affected by the Tubbs Fire.

BACKGROUND

- In May 2018, BPU awarded Construction Contract C02222 with TerraCon Constructors, Inc. in the amount of \$2,305,732.00 for the replacement of contaminated water service lines inside the Advisory Area.
- During this time, PG&E was performing utility replacement work under City encroachment permits inside the Fountaingrove Advisory Area.

BACKGROUND

- The City coordinated underground utility restoration work with PG&E as both entities were performing work inside the Fountaingrove Advisory Area.
- The City and PG&E desired to work cooperatively to expedite the work in the project areas.

PROPOSED

 PG&E has agreed to provide \$1,328,325.00 in funding to the City to complete the pavement restoration work requirements arising from the PG&E Northern Fire Rebuild Joint Trench Project.

RECOMMENDATION

 It is recommended by the Transportation and Public Works Department that the City Council, by resolution, approve the agreement with PG&E for future pavement restoration in neighborhoods affected by the Tubbs Fire. The agreement will allow the City to accept \$1,328,325.00 towards future pavement restoration, where both PG&E and the City completed underground utility replacement projects within the same areas affected by the Tubbs Fire.
