Thank you for declining to bring any type of "ceasefire in Gaza" resolution into your agenda. As a Santa Rosa resident, it is important to me that the City Council remain focused on things that can be directly affected.

Additionally, communities across the Bay Area are being divided over the appropriateness and language in these types of resolutions, to the point that there have been physical altercations at and outside of public meetings.
