

FIRST AMENDMENT TO TANNERY CREEK AGREEMENT FOR LICENSE PLATE RECOGNITION EQUIPMENT AND MAINTENANCE

CURRENT

- The City purchased an autoChalk Automated License Plate Recognition (ALPR) system from Tannery Creek Systems, Inc. in 2010.
- The City's Parking Division uses ALPR equipment to enforce time limits and obtain parking occupancy data.

PROPOSED

 This resolution proposes that the ALPR maintenance services agreement with Tannery Creek Systems, Inc. be continued for a five-year term.

BENEFIT

 Approval of this item will extend the life and use of the Tannery Creek Systems, Inc. automated license plate recognition equipment used for parking enforcement.

RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended by the Finance Department that the Council, by resolution, approve an Amendment to a cooperative agreement under a contract awarded by the City of Santa Barbara and approved by the City of Santa Rosa's City Manager, for maintenance services serving two Automated License Plate Reader (ALPR) systems for a five-year period, with Tannery Creek Systems, Inc., Vaughan, Ontario, Canada, for additional compensation of \$105,230.
