



RESOLUTION – APPROVAL OF PURCHASE OF FOUR REPLACEMENT PARATRANSIT BUSES

City Council Meeting
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CURRENT

- Four of the twelve vehicles in the Transit Division's Paratransit fleet have exceeded their scheduled useful life
- Transit Division has been awarded FTA Section 5310 funding from a 2017 grant application for the purchase of four replacement ADA vehicles
- A Cooperative agreement is available to provide agencies a purchasing mechanism that benefits from economy of scale.

PROPOSED

- Use the Cal-ACT-MBTA Joint Purchasing Cooperative Solicitation
- Purchase four ADA Paratransit vehicles to replace vehicles that exceeded useful life

BENEFIT

- Increase reliability for Santa Rosa Paratransit passengers
- Reduce maintenance costs
- Reduce GHG emissions
- Benefit from economy of scale using a state-wide contract

RECOMMENDATION

- It is recommended by the Transportation and Public Works Department that the Council, by resolution, authorize the purchase of four replacement paratransit buses using the CalACT-MBTA Purchasing Cooperative from a successful bidder, Creative Bus Sales, Inc., at a total cost of \$345,410.56.
