



Transportation Development Act (TDA) Article 3 Grant Application For Fiscal Year 2020/2021

BACKGROUND

- Transportation Development Act (TDA) funds are generated from a statewide ¼ cent sales tax. Article 3 of TDA sets aside of approximately 2% of those monies for bicycle and pedestrian planning and projects. The Metropolitan Transportation Commission (MTC) administers TDA Article 3, which is distributed based on population.
- The City annually receives TDA Article 3 funding for bicycle and pedestrian projects.

RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended by the Transportation and Public Works Department that Council, by resolution,

- 1) request that the Metropolitan Transportation Commission (MTC) allocate \$450,000 from Fiscal Year (FY) 2020/2021 Transportation Development Act (TDA) Article 3 funds;
- 2) authorize the Director of Transportation and Public Works to file the application and other required documents to install bicycle and pedestrian enhancements on Santa Rosa Avenue between Sonoma Avenue and Maple Avenue and
- 3) this increase in appropriations for JL Key 17474 by \$450,000 of TDA Article 3 funds for the project will occur as part of the FY 2020/2021 CIP budget process
