

In partnership with City of Santa Rosa Water

- The City of Santa Rosa's Water Department and Public Art Program are inviting artists or artist teams to design and create a mural for the concrete fence at the Lower Colgan Creek Restoration Project & Neighborhood Park, located at 3012 Dutton Meadow, Santa Rosa, California.



Artwork Area

Fence dimensions are approximately 588 feet long x 7 feet tall. The artist may use less than the entire fence length, although a larger mural may have a higher impact. The mural may be painted directly on the fence.



Project Information

- Total Project Budget: \$30,000
- Three artists to be selected to completed Request for Proposals and receive an honorarium of \$500 each.
- Selected artist project budget: \$28,500

Eligibility

Artists or artist teams that are local Tribal members or willing to collaborate with local Tribal members and residing in the United States. Applying artist(s) need to demonstrate the ability to execute a successful mural project based on project goals

Request for Qualifications

- Opened November 22, 2024 – January 20, 2025
- Received 18 submissions – currently reviewing for eligibility

Next Steps

- Selection panel round 1 virtual scoring week of February 10 due by Monday February 17
- Selection Panel Round 2 meet week of February 24 – select top three to complete Request for Proposals
- Selection panel estimated to reconvene in May for final artist selection
