GRANT APPLICATION BOATING EDUCATION AND SAFETY

- The application to the DBW is exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA)
- Final award amount determined by DBW – requesting \$6,000
- Grant funds are reimbursed

RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended by the Recreation and Parks Department that the Council, by resolution, (1) approve the submittal of a grant application to the State of California Natural Resources Agency Department of Parks and Recreation Division of Boating and Waterways in the amount of \$6,000 to enhance boating safety and education at Lake Ralphine in Howarth Park; (2) authorize the Director of Recreation and Parks to submit the application, execute agreements and amendments, subject to approval as to form by the City Attorney, and administer the grant; and (3) authorize the Chief Financial Officer to increase appropriations in revenue and expenditures by the approved grant award.
