

3.1.4.3 A Major Donation should provide “substantial” benefit to the City. The term “substantial” in this context is deliberately not defined by arbitrary standards to allow Council the opportunity to appropriately consider all reasonable requests; however, common examples of Major Donations include:~~The thresholds for consideration to name or rename a City Asset for an individual, organization, or business include one or more of the following:~~

3.1.4.3.1 A significant Donation, equal to or greater than ~~50~~25% of the engineer’s estimate, for development of the City Asset including design, permitting, capital construction costs as well as furniture, fixtures and equipment as necessary depending on the City Asset type;
