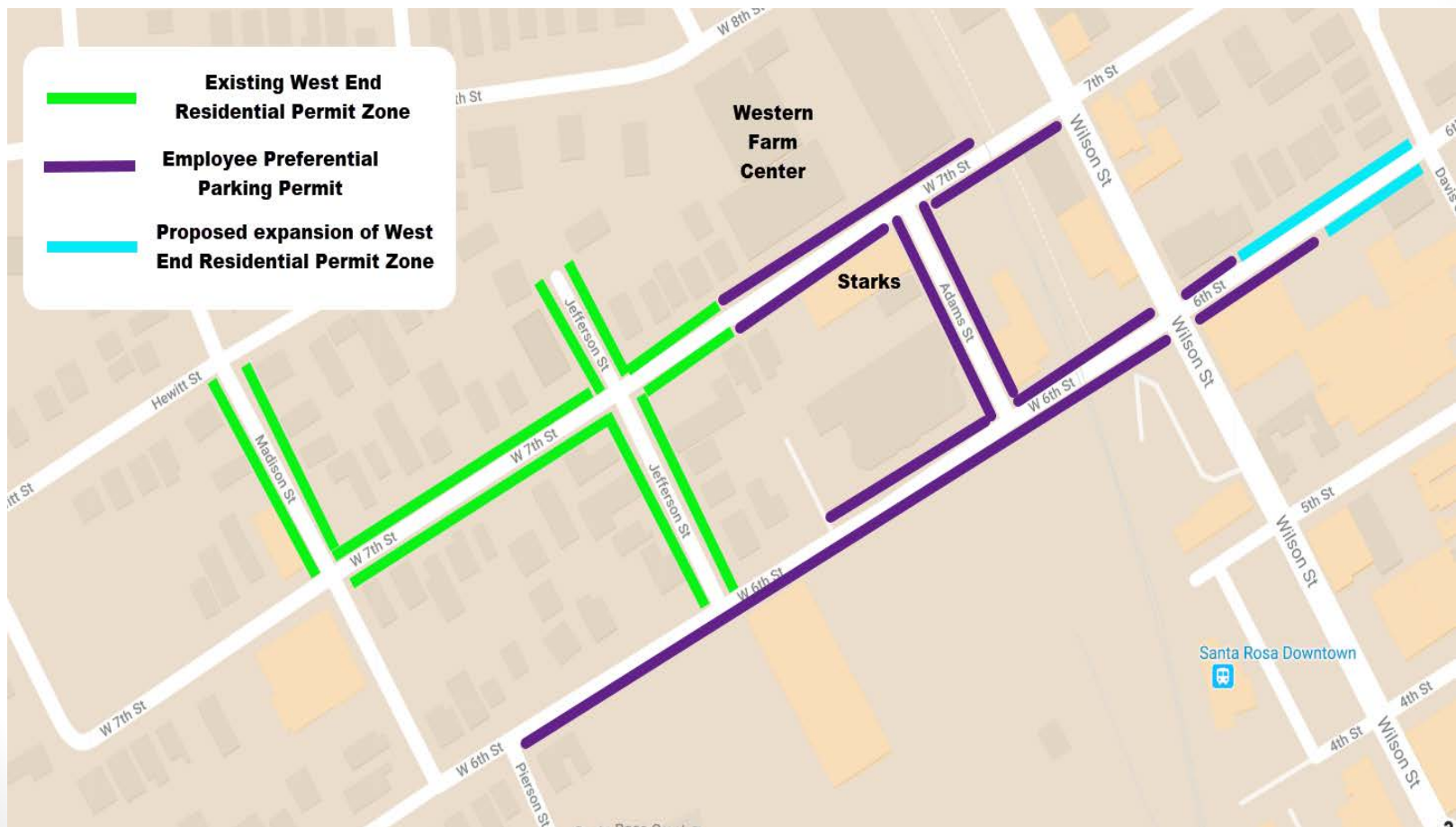
CURRENT

- The West End Residential Permit Parking Zone was established on November 5, 2019
- City Code Section 11-44.050 establishes process for designation
- An employee preferential permit program, in the commercial area of the West End adjacent to the proposed residential permit area, was approved by Council on August 13, 2019

PROPOSED

- A petition has been received from residents of the 100 block of 6th Street to expand the West End Residential Permit Parking Zone
- The zone will have two-hour time limited parking from 9 am to 6 pm, Monday - Saturday
- Residents may purchase permits exempting them from time limits

PROPOSED EXPANSION TO THE WEST END RESIDENTIAL PERMIT PARKING ZONE



BENEFIT

- Approval of this item will provide relief to residents, allowing them to park beyond posted time limits in the permit zone.
- The two-hour time limit will serve as a deterrent to long term spill over parking, freeing up parking spaces for residents.

RECOMMENDATION

- It is recommended by the Finance Department that the Council, by resolution, approve the petition to expand the West End Residential Permit Parking Zone.
