**REQUEST TO REMOVE EMERGENCY ACCESS GATE ON KELSEY KNOLLS
BETWEEN ALTRURIA DRIVE AND BALDWIN WAY**

Dear Residents and Owners,

This letter is to inform you that we have received a letter dated March 9, 2018 and petition to remove the emergency vehicle access gate located on Kelsey Knolls between Altruria Drive and Baldwin Way. Traffic Engineering is working toward that effort and we have received support from the Fire Department and the Police Department for the removal.

In reviewing the City Code and the authority of the City Traffic Engineer, it has been determined that the decision to remove the gate lies with the City Council. The City Traffic Engineer will take forward an item to the City Council for that determination.

Your support and petition are very helpful in this process as it illustrates the desire of a large portion of the community to move forward with the gate removal.
