The following question was raised:

Q: Can staff provide signage requirements as pertains to advertising the cannabis and cannabis products.

A: Pursuant to Zoning Code Section 20-46 and State State's Business and Professions Code Section 26152, a Cannabis Retail facility shall not advertise or market cannabis or **cannabis products** on an advertising sign within 1,000 feet of a day care center, school providing instruction in kindergarten or any grades 1 through 12, playground, or youth center.

The project before the Commission is a Conditional Use Permit, which is transferrable. The project has been conditioned to acquire a Sign Permit for signage. Based on the information above, a new condition has been added that reads as follows:

Plans sets submitted with Sign Permit application shall include an exhibit that identifies all day care centers, schools providing instruction in kindergarten or any grades 1 through 12, playgrounds or youth centers within 1,000 feet of the subject site.

The revised resolution has been updated for your review.
