



PO Awards - Pumps

CURRENT

- The Water Department needs to replace aging equipment that is at the end of its useful lifespan. The Fleet Management Section of the City's Transit & Public Works Department is responsible for the management and replacement of City equipment in the replacement fund.
- On June 15, 2016, Request For Quotes (RFQ)16-29 was opened for a single skid-mounted pump.

CURRENT (Continued)

- On August 4, 2016, RFQ 16-33 was opened for three (3) trailer-mounted pumps.
- All four pumps will replace existing equipment that are used at pump lift stations for emergency standby and bypass of sewage through the lift station.

PROPOSED

- Water and TPW staff reviewed the bid submissions for each of the RFQs. The review of the bid proposal documents compared the RFQ requirements to the proposed technical aspects of the item(s), which also included exceptions to the requirements as specified by each vendor.
- Proposals also include a not-to-exceed 8 hour limit for training on pump operation.

BENEFIT

- Thomas and Associates has previously provided equipment to the City with satisfactory results.
- The vendor is located in Novato, providing local access for support and training.

RECOMMENDATION

- It is recommended by the Finance, Transportation & Public Works, and Water Departments that the Council, by motion, approve two purchase orders for a total of four pumps to Thomas and Associates, Novato, California, in the total amount not to exceed \$314,379.08.
