



APPROVAL OF 2019 UPDATE TO SANTA ROSA CITYBUS TITLE VI PROGRAM

CURRENT

- Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964 provides that no person shall, on the grounds of race, color or national origin be excluded from participation in, denied the benefits of, or be subjected to discrimination under any program or activity receiving federal financial assistance.
- Federal Transit Administration (FTA) requires grantees to document their compliance with Title VI by submitting a Title VI Program update once every three years.

PROPOSED

- Council approval of 2019 Title VI Program update, including the following elements:
 - Public notice of protections from discrimination
 - Procedures for filing a Title VI complaint
 - List of any Title VI complaints, investigations or lawsuits naming Santa Rosa CityBus
 - Public participation plan
 - Language assistance plan to ensure access to services for individuals with Limited English Proficiency
 - Systemwide service standards and policies to ensure that transit services and amenities are deployed in a non-discriminatory manner.

BENEFIT

- Documents the Transit Division's compliance with Title VI and related FTA regulations in delivering Santa Rosa CityBus and Santa Rosa Paratransit services

RECOMMENDATION

- It is recommended by the Transportation and Public Works Department that the Council, by resolution, approve the 2019 update to the Santa Rosa CityBus Title VI Program addressing the Transit Division's responsibilities under Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964.
