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AN URGENCY ORDINANCE OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SANTA ROSA TEMPORARILY REGULATING RESIDENTIAL TENANT EVICTIONS IN THE CITY OF SANTA ROSA

The proposed ordinance does the following:

Temporarily Restricts the Termination of Residential Tenancies.

For so long as the City of Santa Rosa remains subject to a state or federal declaration of emergency arising from the wildfires of 2017, a residential tenancy shall not be terminated, nor shall its renewal be refused, except for one or more of the following reasons:

- (a) Nonpayment of Rent.
- (b) Repeated Late Payment of Rent.
- (c) Violation of Obligation of Tenancy.
- (d) Nuisance.
- (e) Illegal Use.
- (f) Refusal to Renew Lease.
- (g) Refusal to Provide Access.
- (h) Correction of Violations; Government Order.
- (i) Withdrawal of Residential Rental Structure from the Rental Market.
- (j) Owner or Relative Occupancy.
