REUNIFICATION OF COURTHOUSE SQUARE

Construction Progress

- 16 weeks of construction
- Demolition and grading
- Sewer, water and storm drain trenching and pipe installation
- Widened planters around some redwoods



REUNIFICATION OF COURTHOUSE SQUARE

Circulation Update

Pedestrian Circulation

- Walkways along east and west sides of the Square to remain open
- Walkways along north and south sides of Square closed
- Fourth Street temporary mid-block crosswalks at the east and west ends of Square. Council action August 16



REUNIFICATION OF COURTHOUSE SQUARE

Naming Plaza and Streets

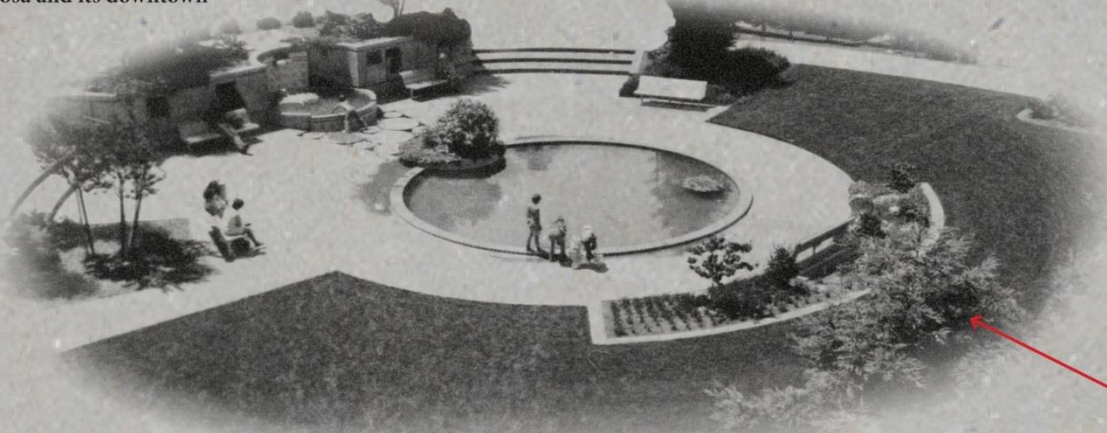
- Courthouse Square established as a public park in 1854
- Land dedicated for public use by Julio Carrillo and Barney Hoen
 - Carrillo Street north of College Avenue
 - Hoen Avenue near Montgomery High School
- Originally Exchange Avenue on west side,
and Hinton Avenue on east side
- Plaza and center street section named
“Old Courthouse Square” in 1966, by Council
- Confirm name of plaza and streets as
“Old Courthouse Square”

ROSENBERG FOUNTAIN

The fountain, designed by landscape architect Leland H. Noel, was a gift from Jessie Rosenberg to the City of Santa Rosa in memory of her beloved husband, Mr. Fred S. Rosenberg. Fred Rosenberg was a patron of downtown development, a well-respected and active community member, and a champion for Santa Rosa. Originally built in 1971 and demolished in 2016, the fountain provided a serene place to sit and observe downtown.

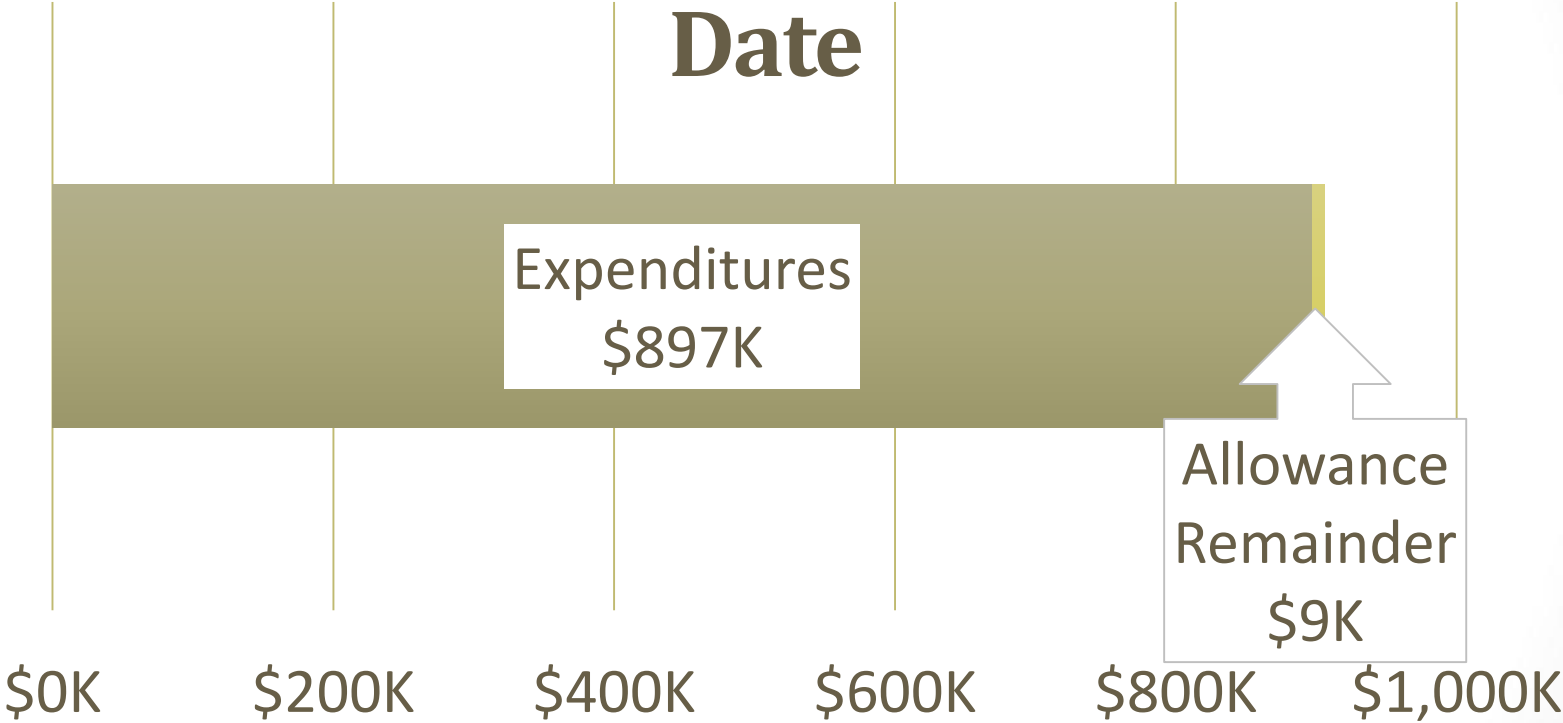

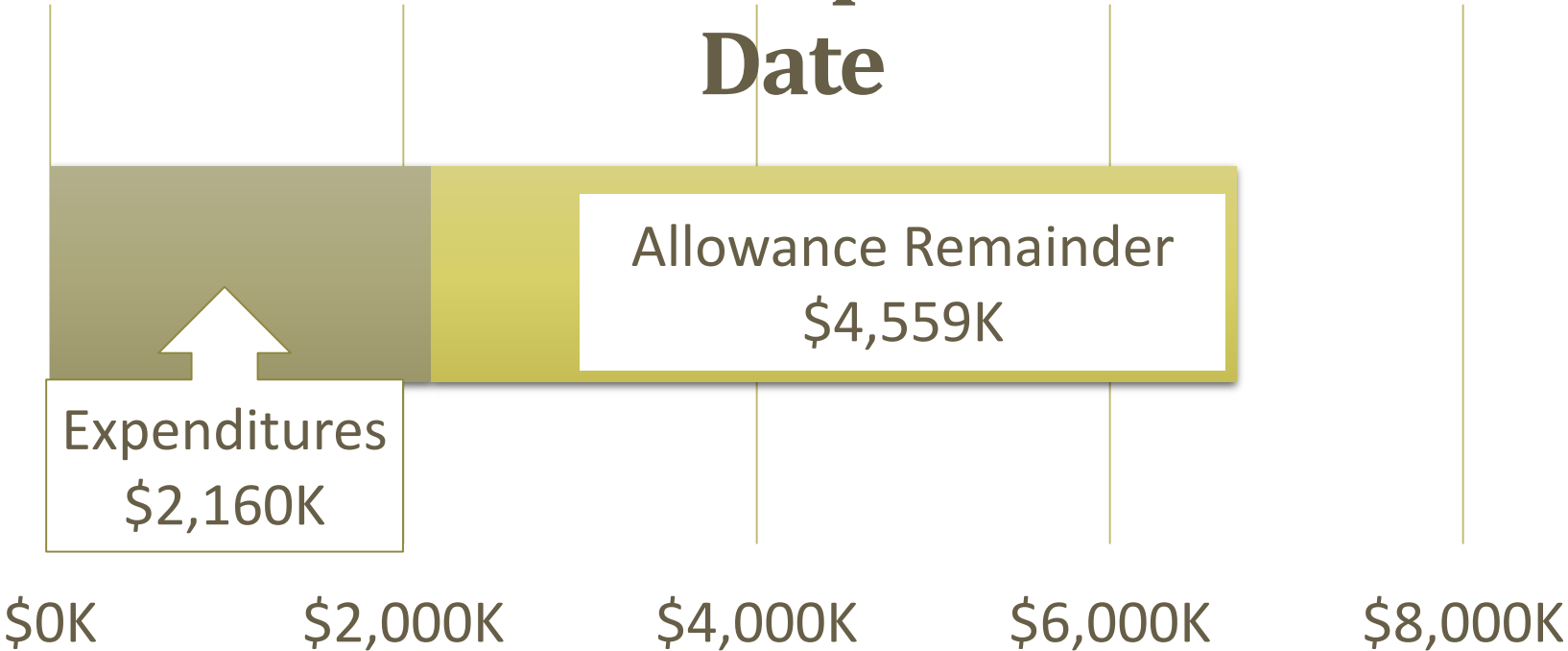

Project Design Expenditures To Date



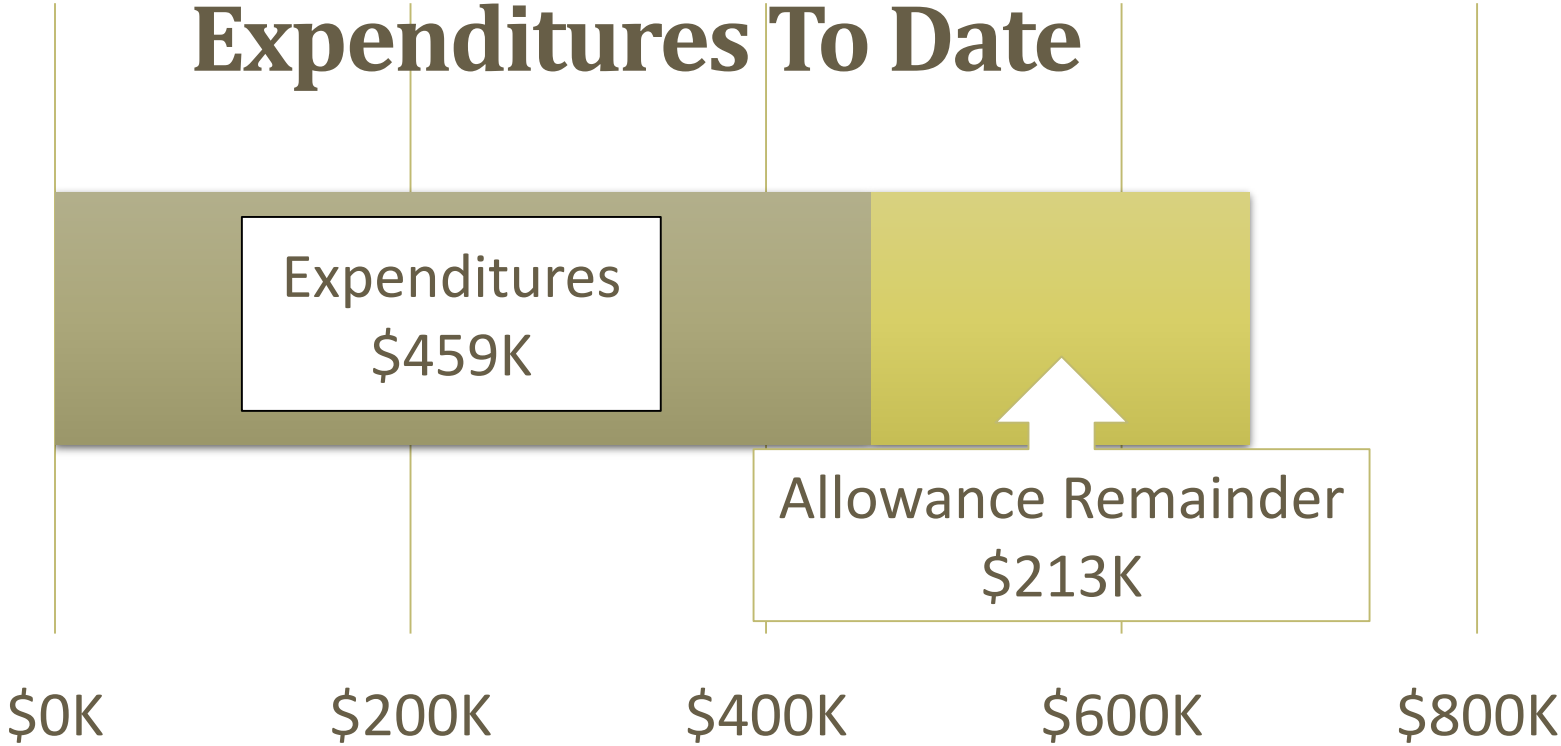

Construction Expenditures To Date



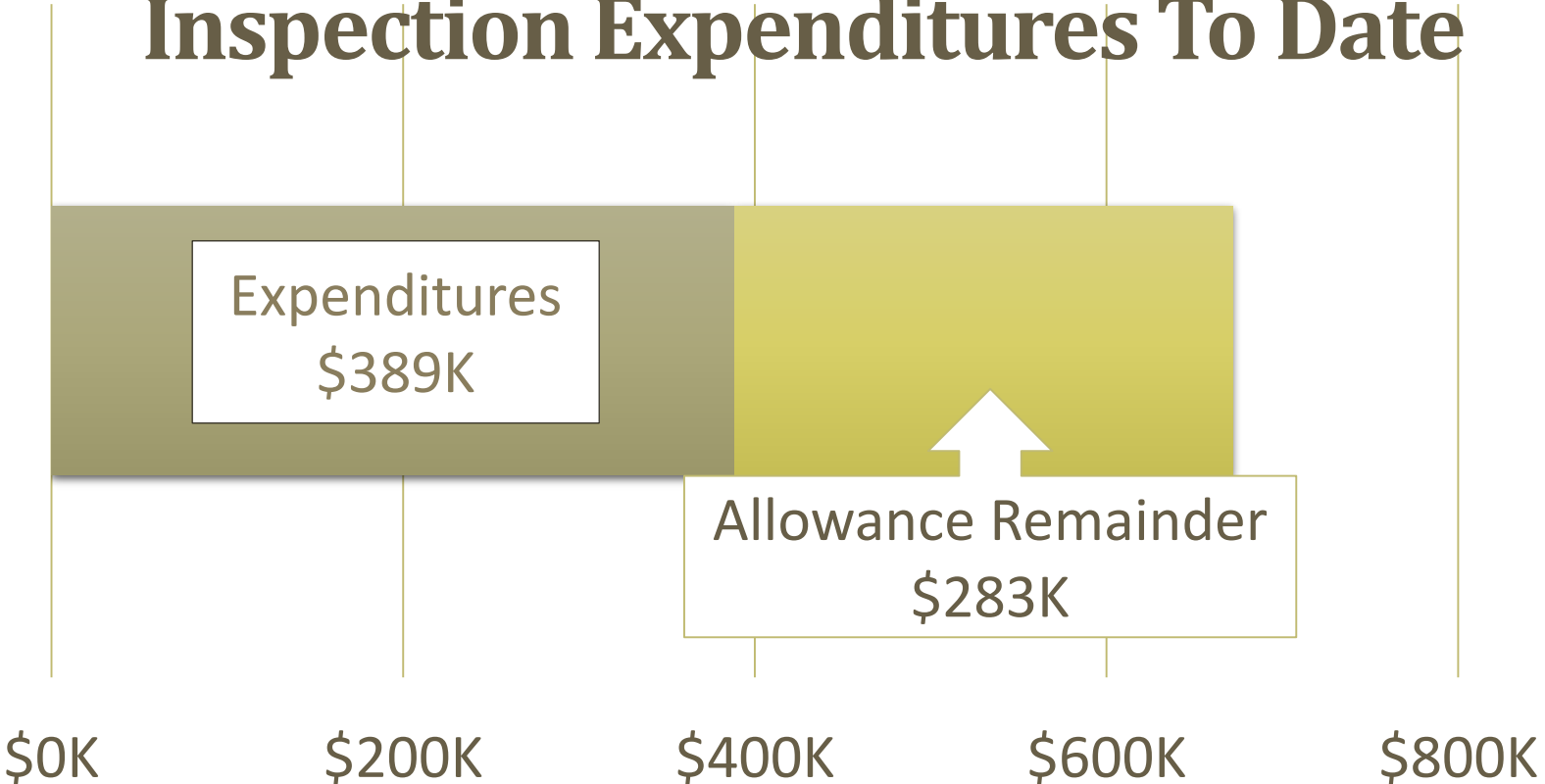

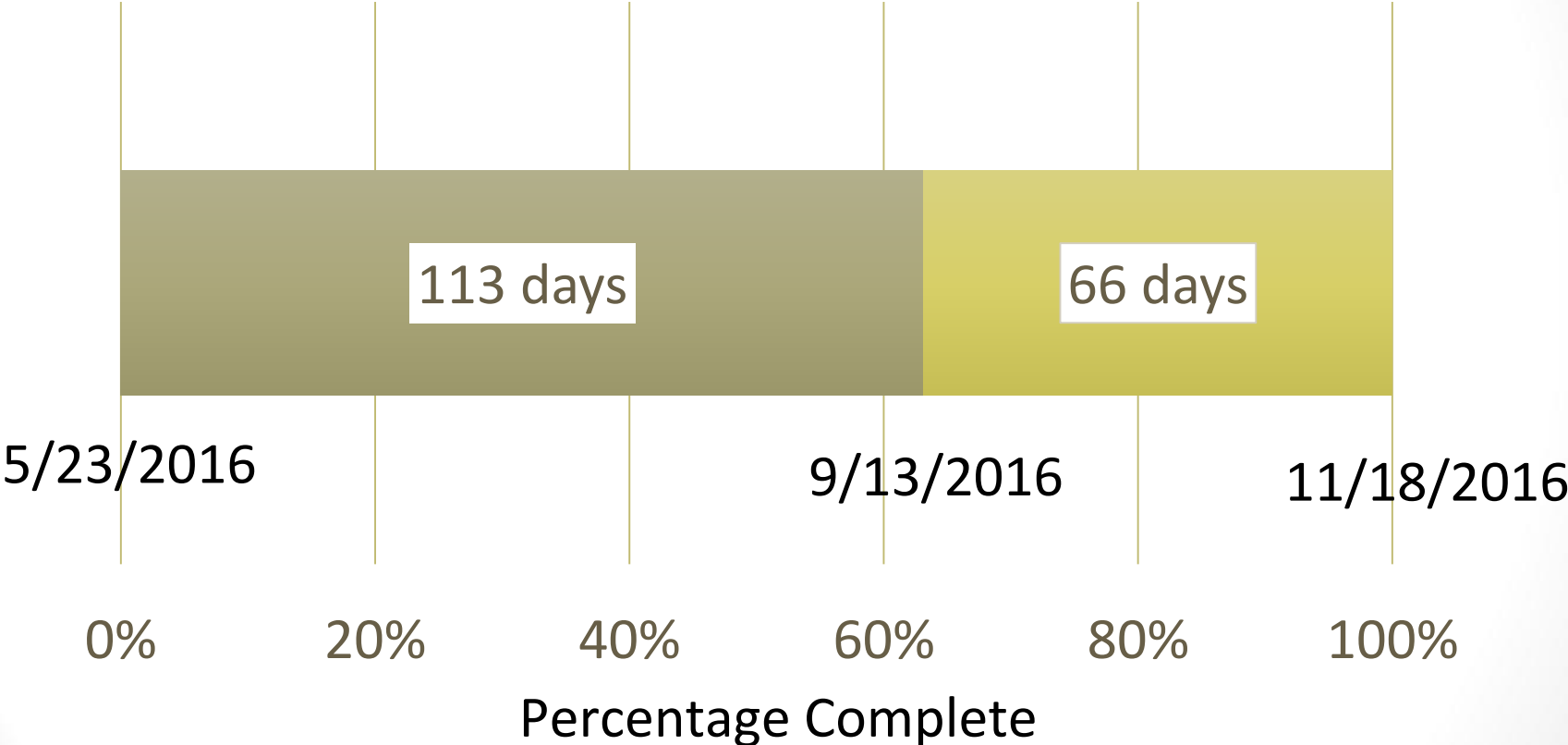
