CURRENT

- The Metropolitan Transportation Commission (MTC) requires a resolution adopted by the governing board to be included in the grant application for the Transit Performance Initiative Program
- MTC has remaining One Bay Area Grant funding for a transit project in Sonoma County
- Sonoma County Transit Authority proposed that Santa Rosa utilize these funds
- There is a total of \$411,000 available

PROPOSED

- The TPI grant would cover \$411,000 of the cost of the proposed projects:
 - Technology for transit system management
 - Customer facing technology
 - Improved passenger amenities
- The MTC grant process requires that the grant be submitted at this time with the funds to be available in FY 17-18

RECOMMENDATION

- It is recommended by the Transportation and Public Works Department that the Council, by resolution, authorize the City Manager or designee to execute and file the grant application under the Transit Performance Initiative Program to the Metropolitan Transportation Commission (MTC) for the “Santa Rosa CityBus New Transit System Optimization” project.
