14 duplexes on 1.86 acres



PROJECT DESCRIPTION

- 14 duplexes on 1.86 acres
- 27 residential units, 1 community room
- * 24 3-BR & 3 1-BR units
- Affordability: 26 units targeted to families earning 30%-60% Area Median Income
- Restricted for 55 years
- Building permit applications submitted
- Construction start October 2017, completion August 2018

FINANCING

- Tax Exempt Note
 - Issuer: City of Santa Rosa
 - Funding Lender: Citibank, N.A.
 - Borrower: Limited Partnership (Central Valley Coalition for Affordable Housing, Urban Housing Communities, RBC Capital Markets)
- Investor Equity: RBC Capital Markets
- Housing Authority Loans
- Deferred Developer Fee

BENEFIT

- 27 affordable units soon under construction
- New style of affordable housing: duplexes with garages and yards
- Most units 3 bedrooms
- No fiscal impact on the City's General Fund
 - all financial obligations responsibility of borrower
- Located in the Aston Avenue NRP Area

RECOMMENDATION

Authorize the sale, execution and delivery of the tax-exempt City of Santa Rosa 2017 Multifamily Housing Revenue Note (The Crossings on Aston Apartments) in a maximum aggregate principal amount of \$7,105,000.
