RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SANTA ROSA APPROVING A MATCHING GRANT APPLICATION TO THE SONOMA COUNTY AGRICULTURAL PRESERVATION AND OPEN SPACE DISTRICT FOR IMPROVEMENTS AT LOWER COLGAN CREEK NEIGHBORHOOD PARK IN THE AMOUNT OF \$2,500,000, AUTHORIZING THE ASSISTANT CITY MANAGER TO NEGOTIATE AND EXECUTE THE GRANT AGREEMENT AND ADMINISTER THE GRANT, AND AUTHORIZING THE CHIEF FINANCIAL OFFICER TO INCREASE APPROPRIATIONS BY THE APPROVED GRANT AWARD

WHEREAS, in accordance with the voter-approved Expenditure Plan, the Sonoma County Agricultural Preservation and Open Space District (District) has established a competitive Matching Grant Program for projects that provide open space, community recreation, or public access opportunities within and near incorporated areas and other urbanized areas of Sonoma County; and

WHEREAS, the City of Santa Rosa Transportation and Public Works Department (Department) has identified development of the Lower Colgan Creek Neighborhood Park Project (Project) as a priority, in alignment with Council Goal 5, *Build and Maintain Sustainable Infrastructure*; and

WHEREAS, the District released guidelines and application materials for a second round of the 2022 funding cycle with applications due on March 10, 2023; and

WHEREAS, the Department has reviewed, understands, and agrees to the provisions contained in the District's Program Guidelines; and

WHEREAS, the Project meets the criteria for the District's Program, and will improve a portion of the approximately 4-acres of public recreational parkland with play features, picnic areas, and pathways adjacent to the Lower Colgan Creek habitat and a multi-use pathway; and

WHEREAS, the total cost for the design and construction of the improvements is estimated at \$2,500,000; and

WHEREAS, the District's Matching Grant Program requires applicants to provide the equivalent of a one-to-one match for the project; and

WHEREAS, the application is requesting \$1,000,000 in grant funding for the Project, with the source of the required one-to-one matching funds and remainder of the project costs available from the Park Development Impact fees from the Southwest Zone 2.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Council of the City of Santa Rosa authorizes the filing of a grant application for the Lower Colgan Creek Neighborhood Park improvements including play features, picnic areas and pathways to the Sonoma County Agricultural Preservation and Open Space District's Matching Grant Program, in an amount not

to exceed \$1,000,000.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Council authorizes the Assistant City Manager to accept the grant, execute any and all agreements, conservation easements and amendments thereto, and all other documents necessary for the completion of the design and construction of the park improvement project, and subject to approval by the City Attorney.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Council, upon approval of the grant agreement, authorizes the Chief Financial Officer to increase appropriations in JL Key 09605, Lower Colgan Creek Neighborhood Park, equal to the approved grant amount.
