THE CITY COUNCIL WILL INTRODUCE AN ORDINANCE FOR MUNICIPAL AND ZONING CODE TEXT AMENDMENTS TO IMPLEMENT THE 2023-2031 HOUSING ELEMENT - FILE NUMBER PLN25-0397.

Notice is hereby given that a public hearing will be conducted by the City Council on Tuesday, March 10, 2026, at or after 5:00 p.m. The purpose of the public hearing will be to receive public comment and recommendations prior to the City Council acting on the proposed Zoning Code Amendments to implement two Housing Element Programs to: 1) Comply with State Law for housing types such as Residential Care Facilities, Reasonable Accommodations, Accessory Dwelling Units, and Farmworker Housing and 2) Provide innovative housing options for the City through allowing Tiny Homes on Wheels in Single-Family zoning districts.
