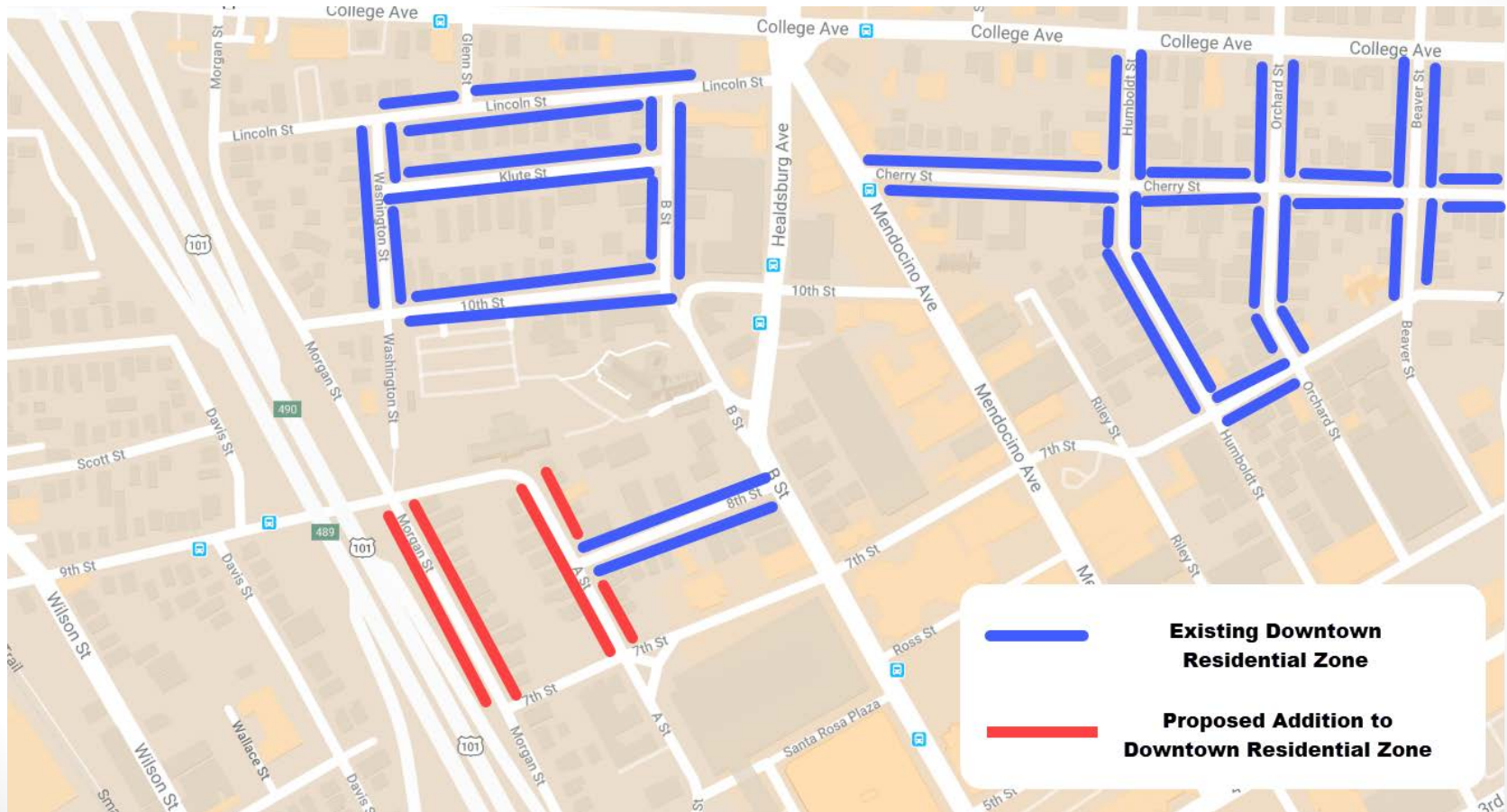
# CURRENT

- The 500 block of A Street and the 700 block of Morgan Street do not currently have a residential permit program
- City Code Section 11-44 establishes the process for designation of a permit zone
- Residents are impacted from long term spill-over parking

# PROPOSED

- A petition has been received from residents of A Street and Morgan Street to be included in the Downtown residential permit parking zone
- The zone has two-hour time limited parking from 9 am to 6 pm, Monday -Saturday
- Residents may purchase permits exempting them from time limits

# PETITION REQUIREMENTS

City Code Section 11-44.050 requires signatures from at least 60% of the housing units in the proposed area and on each proposed block front.

- 500 block A Street                      67%
- 700 block Morgan Street              63%

# BENEFIT

- Approval of this item will provide relief to residents, allowing them to park beyond posted time limits in the permit zone.
- The two-hour time limit will serve as a deterrent to long term spill over parking, freeing up parking spaces for residents.

# RECOMMENDATION

- It is recommended by the Finance Department that the City Council, by resolution, approve the A Street and Morgan Street petition to be included in the Downtown Residential Permit Parking Program.
