# Fire Affected Parks Summary

10 Park and Open Space sites estimated area affected:

- Community Parks - 9.35 acres - (\$123,936)
  - Nagasawa (\$123,936), Howarth (\$0)
- Neighborhood Parks - 11.49 acres - (\$6,161,906)
  - Coffey (\$5-million), Fir Ridge (\$355,507), Rincon Ridge (\$548,739), Francis Nielsen (\$257,660)
- Open Space - 25.89 acres - (\$658,710)
  - Francis Nielsen (\$25,696), Parker Hill (\$567,627), Rincon Ridge (\$65,387), Thomas Lake Harris (\$0)

**Total Park areas damaged: 46.73 acres (\$6,944,552)**

- Additional 13 acres of damage to City owned and maintained landscapes (\$4,685,603)

# Path to Recovery

- FEMA and Cal OES site visits complete
- FEMA grant requests submitted
- Arborist report for street and park tree removal - ongoing
- Removal/disposal of hazardous materials, including street trees - ongoing
- Community outreach -underway
- Plans to redevelop damaged areas as funding is available
- Implement new construction at all damaged sites, beginning 2019
- Coffey park closed – all other parks are open – use caution, stay on paths, avoid closed areas/items
