Sequencing Process

GOAL:

***Select 3 districts for 2018 Election Cycle.
The remaining 4 districts will vote in the
general election in 2020.***

OPTION 1

Elimination Voting – beginning with 4 votes each and decreasing each round; vote until 3 districts have majority. (4 votes move forward – 0 votes eliminated)

Sequencing Process

OPTION 2

Discuss each district independently – vote whether to include in 2018 or 2020. If more than 3 districts selected for 2018, run-off votes to narrow selection to 3.

Sequencing Process

OPTION 3

Incumbency Consideration –

- a) Districts with only one representative residing in that district and whose term expires in 2018;
- b) Districts with any incumbent whose term expires in 2018.

OPTION 4

Random Selection – Pull 3 districts from hat.

Sequencing Process

OPTION 5

Annexation Consideration –

- a) Should the newly annexed area vote for a district representative in 2018? (Y/N).
- b) If yes, should remaining 2 districts represent opposite sides of 101? (Y/N)
If yes, remaining districts separated into two hats and randomly drawn from hat.

(Note – if answer to (a) is no – select other option)
