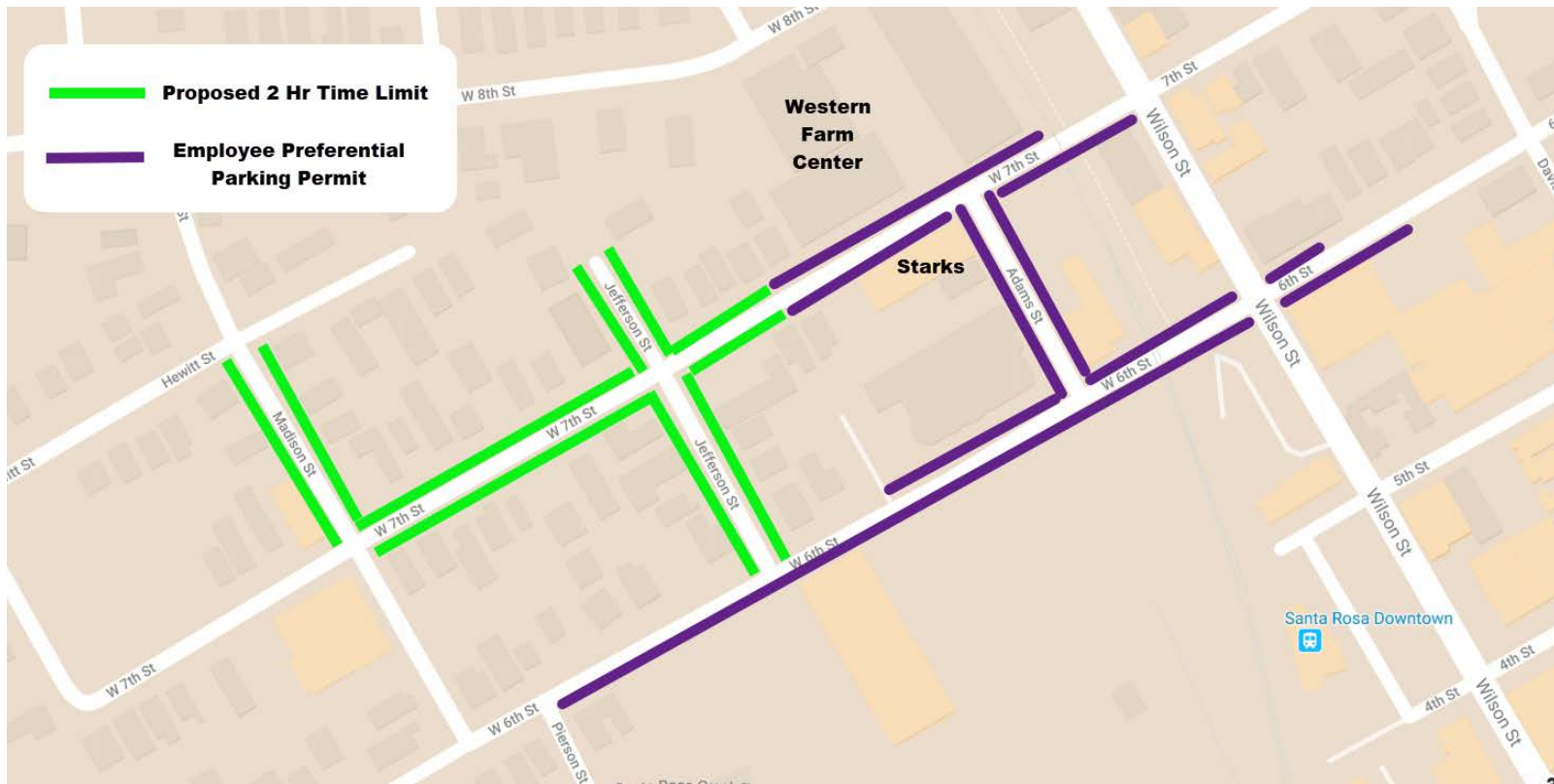
CURRENT

- The West End neighborhood does not currently have a residential permit program
- City Code Section 11-44 establishes the process for designation of permit area
- An employee preferential permit program, in the commercial area of the West End adjacent to the proposed residential permit area, was approved by Council on August 13, 2019

PROPOSED

- A petition has been received from residents of the West End to establish a residential permit parking zone
- The zone will have two-hour time limited parking from 9 am to 6 pm, Monday -Saturday
- Residents may purchase permits exempting them from time limits

PROPOSED WEST END RESIDENTIAL PERMIT PARKING ZONE



PETITION REQUIREMENTS

City Code Section 11-44.050 requires signatures from at least 60% of the housing units in the proposed area and on each proposed block front.

- 500 block Jefferson 80%
- 600 block Jefferson 100%
- 00 block West 7th 71%
- 100 block West 7th 71%
- 600 block Madison 100%

BENEFIT

- Approval of this item will provide relief to residents, allowing them to park beyond posted time limits in the permit zone.
- The two-hour time limit will serve as a deterrent to long term spill over parking, freeing up parking spaces for residents.

RECOMMENDATION

- It is recommended by the Finance Department that the City Council, by resolution, approve the petition to establish the West End Residential Permit Parking Zone.
