BACKGROUND

- In the time since Council adopted the current Public Art Policy, the Public Art Program has been relocated from the Recreation & Parks Department to the Planning & Economic Development Department.
- To continue effectively implementing the program, signature authority over specific art agreements delegated to the Director of Recreation & Parks must be updated to the City Manager or his/her designee.

RECOMMENDATION

- It is recommended by the Planning & Economic Development Department that Council, by resolution, adopt the Amended Council Policy 000-42 “Public Art,” updating the signature authority over specific art agreements from the Director of Recreation and Parks to the City Manager or his/her designee.
