

**SECOND AMENDMENT  
TO GENERAL SERVICES AGREEMENT NUMBER F001847  
WITH WEINSTEIN SECURITY, INC.**

This Second Amendment to Agreement number F001847, dated January 15, 2019 (“Agreement”) is made as of this \_\_\_\_\_ day of \_\_\_\_\_, 2020, by and between the City of Santa Rosa, a municipal corporation (“City”), and Weinstein Security Inc., a California Corporation (“Contractor”).

**RECITALS**

- A. City and Contractor entered into the Agreement for Contractor to provide unarmed security services for various City locations, as previously amended.
- B. City and Contractor now desire to amend the Agreement for the purpose of extending services for City Parking Garages through the term of the agreement, and increasing compensation.

**AMENDMENT**

**NOW, THEREFORE**, the parties agree to amend the Agreement as follows:

1. SCOPE OF SERVICES

Exhibit A and Exhibit A-1 to the Agreement are supplemented by Exhibit A-2 to this Amendment.

2. COMPENSATION

Exhibit B and Exhibit B-1 to the Agreement are supplement by Exhibit B-2 to this Amendment. Section 4 of the Agreement is amended to increase the compensation payable to Contractor under the Agreement by \$243,524.40 to read as follows:

“The total of all fees paid to Contractor for the satisfactory performance and completion of all services set forth in the Agreement shall not exceed the total sum of \$1,182,786.39. The Chief Financial Officer is authorized to pay all proper claims from various Charge Numbers.”

All other terms of the Agreement shall remain in full force and effect.

## **EXHIBIT A-2**

### **PARKING GARAGE SERVICES**

During entire duration of patrols, the security guard will receive and respond to calls from parking garage intercoms directly to the security guard cell phone. The security guard uses their assigned access card to let the vehicle out of the garage, then the guard files an incident report in Tracktik. In the incident report, include a description of what caused the patron to call for service. Include the time the call was received, and the time the patron was let out of the garage.
