



# Approval of Fifth Amendment to General Service Agreement Number F01776 with Petrusha Enterprises, Inc. dba Advanced Security Systems

# CURRENT

- The City has a need for 24/7 monitoring of intrusion and fire alarm systems and notification to department staff of alarm prior to contacting police and fire dispatch.
- There is also a need for the Vendor to respond to on-call maintenance requests of the intrusion alarm, key entry, and security systems and components.
- The City uses a licensed contractor to provide these services.

# PROPOSED

- Extended term for two years with no increase in unit cost.
- Increase compensation by \$70,000 for a total amount not to exceed \$150,788.

# BENEFIT

- Continued fire and burglar monitoring
- No increase in unit cost for two years

# RECOMMENDATION

- Approve the Fifth Amendment to General Service Agreement Number F001776, to extend the term for two years and increase compensation by \$70,000 for fire and burglar alarm monitoring services with Petrusha Enterprises, Inc. dba Advanced Security Systems, for a total amount not to exceed \$150,788.
