#### RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended by the Transportation and Public Works and Finance Departments that the Council, by resolution, approve a purchase order for two (2) 2020 Ford F-550 Class 5 Standard Cab & Chassis with 9FT 3-4 Dump Body (for Water Department) to Towne Ford, Redwood City, California, in the total amount not to exceed \$133.377.10.

### **EXECUTIVE SUMMARY**

The Transportation and Public Works Department submitted a request to Purchasing for the purchase of two (2) 2020 or Newer Class 5 2WD DRW Standard Cab and Chassis with 9FT 3-4 Yard Dump Body.

#### BACKGROUND

Under the City's guidelines for replacement of fleet vehicles, the Transportation and Public Works Department (TPW) Fleet Maintenance Division selects a vehicle for replacement when it has reached the end of its cost-effective life cycle. These vehicles have met the replacement criteria using a point system, an industry standard to predict when best to sell a vehicle. Repair costs, age, and mileage are considered in the point calculation performed by our Faster Fleet software system.

This purchase will replace the following City vehicles below:

- 14818 67,352 Miles, Utilities Field Operations, Collection System Repair
- 14602 112,687 Miles, Utilities Field Operations, Collection System Repair

### <u>ANALYSIS</u>

On April 22, 2020, Invitation for Bids (IFB) 20-37 was opened by Purchasing. Of the one hundred ninety-one (191) vendors notified, sixteen (16) prospective bidders downloaded the documents for this solicitation. Six (6) bidders responded, two of the six bids were deemed responsive and responsible. The bid received from Towne Ford, Redwood City, CA was the lowest responsive and responsible bid.
