

RESOLUTION NO. RES-2023-194

RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SANTA ROSA EXPANDING THE DOWNTOWN RESIDENTIAL PERMIT PARKING ZONE TO INCLUDE THE 300 BLOCK OF LINCOLN STREET SITUATED BETWEEN WASHINGTON STREET AND MORGAN STREET WITHIN THE DOWNTOWN RESIDENTIAL PERMIT PARKING ZONE

WHEREAS, the Finance Department received a petition from residents of the 300 block of Lincoln Street requesting to be included in the Downtown Residential Permit Parking Zone; and

WHEREAS, City Code Section 11-44.050 establishes the procedure for creating Residential Permit Parking Zones; and

WHEREAS, the petition represents 62% of residential units on the 300 block of Lincoln Street (8 of 13) proposed for inclusion in the Downtown Residential Permit Parking Zone, depicted on the attached Exhibit A; and

WHEREAS, the Department held a Neighborhood Meeting with residents, on October 3, 2023, to review the issues and discuss the merits of modifying the Downtown Residential Permit Parking Zone to include the 300 block of Lincoln Street; and

WHEREAS, it has been determined that this block meets the City's requirements for inclusion in the Residential Permit Parking Program; and

WHEREAS, the Department and residents have reached agreement on parking restrictions, including a 2-hour time limit from 9:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m., Monday through Friday.
