Greetings Ms. Sheikhali: Thank you for sharing this information. We join in the comments already submitted by Mr. and Mrs. Arnold. In addition, we would note that the sound test, with results reported for hearing at approximately five feet from ground level, does not address the situation of the Flamingo courts. We are uphill neighbors, and it is our experience that sound from the hotel and health club is amplified by the hill. We would expect that an adequate sound study would reflect the residential situation and base-of-hill location of the health club courts.

I am emailing you to let you know about scheduling the Flamingo Hotel Health Club pickleball project for the Zoning Administrator's public hearing on May 16th. I still need to prepare all the notices and the resolution. The notices will go out to neighbors within 600 feet, and two signs will be posted on-site. Like the last notice, you and your neighbors should receive a postcard before the meeting.

The applicant has provided a letter from the tarp installer, including a noise study done for eight pickleball courts in Walnut Creek. The study concludes that installing the sound-absorbing acoustic panels will reduce the noise from the courts. I am relying on the report and the support
