

RESOLUTION NO. RES-2018-015

RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SANTA ROSA APPROVING THE RELOCATION OF PUBLIC ART INSTALLATION ZAG, A LIGHT SCULPTURE

WHEREAS, Council Policy 000-42 “Public Art” requires Council approval for relocation of art in the Public Art Collection; and

WHEREAS, “Zag”, a light sculpture by Michael Hayden, was privately commissioned in 2002 and installed on the pedestrian bridge over the Santa Rosa Creek near Olive Park; and

WHEREAS, vandalism and lack of maintenance by the owners caused the art to become inoperable and the art was eventually abandoned; and

WHEREAS, on October 10, 2016, the Art in Public Places Committee by motion, accessioned the artwork “Zag” into the Public Art Collection and recommended its repair and relocation; and

WHEREAS, the recommended relocation from its current site on the pedestrian bridge over the Santa Rosa Creek near Olive Park to the pedestrian bridge near the entry to Prince Memorial Greenway at Prince Gateway Park will site “Zag” in a more visible location.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Council of the City of Santa Rosa hereby approves the relocation of “Zag” to the pedestrian bridge near the entry to Prince Memorial Greenway at Prince Gateway Park.
