SUBJECT: PUBLIC HEARING ON FISCAL YEAR 2020/21 BUDGET
PRIORITIES

RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended by the Finance Department, that the Council hold a public hearing on budget priorities and consider written and oral comments as part of future budget deliberations. No action is necessary.

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

Every year, pursuant to the City Charter, the City Council holds a public hearing to solicit input from the community on priorities to be considered for the upcoming budget. This meeting complies with Charter requirements relative to posting and being held prior to the City Council goal setting meeting. It also marks the kick-off of the Fiscal Year (FY) 2020/21 budget process.

BACKGROUND

The City Charter, Section 28(a), states that "...not later than March 31st of each year and prior to any annual goal setting meeting held by the Council, the Council shall hold a public hearing seeking oral and written comment from the public on budget priorities for the upcoming fiscal year."

Public input is an important component to the preparation of the budget. This public hearing also provides information to the City Council as they establish and refine their Council Goals. In addition to this public hearing, members of the public may provide comments or suggestions at any time on the City's website.

PRIOR CITY COUNCIL REVIEW

This is an annual public hearing held by the City Council.

ANALYSIS

Pursuant to City Charter, a public hearing notice to solicit public input on budget priorities for next fiscal year was published in the Press Democrat on January 31, 2020 and again on February 18, 2020. Also pursuant to City Charter, the public hearing on budget priorities will be held prior to the City Council goal setting meeting which is currently scheduled for March 12 & 13, 2020.
