

2017 Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant

BACKGROUND

- The Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant (JAG) Program provides federal funding to local governments for law enforcement activities.
- The U.S. Department of Justice has allocated an amount of \$45,571 for the City of Santa Rosa.
- The Grant requires governing body approval.

PROPOSED

 The Police Department proposes to use this funding towards the hiring of a consultant to assist with the creation of a training facility.

BENEFIT

- A consultant will assist in the creation of a training facility which will be primarily used for active shooter and building search training, and joint police/fire training scenarios and exercises.
- The facility will also provide additional California P.O.S.T. (Police Officer Standards and Training) training opportunities for sworn staff.

RECOMMENDATIONS

 Authorize the City Manager to execute the 2017 JAG agreement and any amendments, subject to approval by the City Attorney.

RECOMMENDATIONS

 Authorize the Chief Financial Officer to recognize the revenue and increase expenditure appropriations by the approved grant amount not to exceed \$45,571.
